### Kapiolani Children's Miracle Network

The organization, which raises money and awareness for hospitalized children, received \$73,800 from **Panda Restaurant Group**. The donation came as more than 1,700 members of the restaurant group and their families met in Hawaii.

### Special Olympics Hawaii

**The First Hawaiian Bank Foundation** donated \$20,000 to support the **Troy Barboza Law Enforcement Torch Run**, the annual kickoff event for the Hawaii State Summer Games.

### Big Brothers Big Sisters of Honolulu

The nonprofit received \$11,000 from **First Insurance Co. of Hawaii**, pro-
