PBS Hawai'i Volunteer, In-Studio Guests, Visitors and Contractors Protocol Effective July 8, 2021

After more than a year hiatus due to COVID-19 related restrictions and protocols, PBS Hawai'i will welcome back volunteers, in-studio guests, visitors and contractors beginning July 8, 2021.

Our top priority is the safety, health and wellness of all. For that reason, we will implement safety measures and an incremental approach to bringing back dedicated volunteers, in-studio guests, visitors and contractors.

Required safety procedures include the mandatory use of masks for all, except for instudio guests during live productions, a limit of 10 volunteers per day, daily wellness checks including temperature checks and social distancing practices. At this time, we are not allowing minors to volunteer in-person.

While Federal law allows businesses to ask visitors for proof of vaccination, PBS Hawai'i will not require vaccinations to enter our facility.

Please review the following additions to our volunteer, in-studio guests, visitors and contractor protocol:

Health & Safety Guidelines

- Effective July 8, 2021 all new and returning volunteers, in-studio guests and visitors, must complete the PBS Hawai'i Volunteer, In-Studio Guests, Visitors and Contractor Application.
- All Volunteers, In-Studio Guests, Visitors and Contractors must register 24 hours ahead of their scheduled visit and sign-in upon arrival.
- All Volunteers, In-Studio Guests, Visitors and Contractors must complete a mandatory temperature screening by PBS Hawai'i staff, and health selfassessment upon arrival to the site.
- If temperature is less than 100.4 (100.3 and BELOW) guest will be allowed into building.
- If temperature is 100.4 or greater, we will ask guest to remain outside for five minutes. Staff will retake temperature. If temperature is less than 100.4, guest will be allowed entrance. If temperature is 100.4 or greater, guest cannot enter site.
- Guests must be fever free for 48 hours, without use of fever reducing medication.
- Volunteers, Contractors and Visitors must correctly wear a face covering (over nose and mouth) at all times and maintain a distance of 6' from staff and others.
- In-Studio Guests must correctly wear a face covering (over nose and mouth) at all times, except during live productions.

- All Volunteers, In-Studio Guests, Visitors and Contractors must use provided hand washing and sanitation stations upon arrival, between tasks, before/after lunch, and as often as possible.
- Volunteer groups are limited to 10 individuals or less.
- PBS Hawai'i has modified volunteer tasks and practices to minimize risk and contact.
