

Behavioral Health Services for Youth

Prevention & Support Services

Project Venture provides school workshops and after-school activities for youth in grades 6-8 that give young people a chance to develop peer support from friendships made in a positive environment, helping them stay on track and reduce the likelihood that they will later engage in dangerous and unhealthy activities.

Support, Outreach & Advocacy

MYFS has numerous counselors who support youth with an array of issues. This can include challenges with grades and attendance at school; homelessness and/or lack of safe shelter; youth in need of independent living skills; assistance with school or job skills. Counselors provide care coordination and warm linkages and referrals to professional assistance.

Residential Services

A variety of programs provide youth with stability and security as they navigate housing challenges, including emergency 24-hour care, foster care for at-risk youth, and independent and transitional living programs for former foster youth.

Substance Use Disorder Services

Programs provide confidential treatment for 12-17 year-olds that includes individual and/or family counseling, group therapy and education about addiction. Transportation can be provided. Services are available on the MYFS Makawao campus, and at Baldwin, Lahainaluna, King Kekaulike and Maui High Schools, Iao and Kihei Intermediate Schools, and Kihei Charter School.
